Income

Grant from St Edmundsbury Borough Council

St Edmundsbury Borough Council cut its Parish Council Support Grant and its Council Tax Support Grant by another 25% in 2016.

VAT Refund

The Council claims back less VAT at the end of each financial year. The VAT receipt of £458.04 relates to the financial year 2014/15. It claimed back less VAT in 2015/16 as it spent less on goods and services in 2014/5 where the VAT could be reclaimed.

Consol dividend

The consol dividend was redeemed in July 2015 so interest was only paid until then.

Allotment Rent

The Council rented more allotments in 2016.

Refund of phone costs

Risby Parish council took out a new phone cheaper phone contract in August 2015 so the amount reclaimed from the other parish councils the clerk works for was lower.

Redemption of Consol Dividend

The consol dividend was redeemed in July 2015 as the scheme folded

Havebury grant for war memorial

Risby Parish Council received a grant from Havebury towards the cost of providing a fence around the war memorial to help protect it

Locality funding for war memorial

Risby Parish Council received a grant from Suffolk County Council towards the cost of providing a fence around the war memorial to help protect it.

Expenditure

Phone costs

Risby Parish council took out a new phone cheaper phone contract in August 2015 so the amount reclaimed from the other parish councils the clerk works for was lower.

Membership of LCPAS and Community Action Suffolk

Risby Parish Council left SALC and took out membership with LCPAS at a cost of £80, a reduction of £221. Membership of SALC in 2014/15 was £301, membership of CAS in both years was £30.

Maintenance services

The Council paid for additional hedge cutting in 2015/16 and carried out tree works recommended in the 2014/15 tree survey.

VAT

The Council paid more VAT in 2015/16 as it spent more on goods and services where VAT can be reclaimed.

Election costs

St Edmundsbury Borough Council charged Risby Parish Council £21.34 for the cost of an uncontested election in May 2015

Replacement litter bins

Risby Parish Council carried out an audit of its bin provision with St Edmundsbury Borough Council and replaced some of the dog and litter bins with a combined bin as this will be a more cost effective option if St Edmundsbury Borough Council starts charging to empty bins in the parish, which it is likely to do. This amount includes the cost of installation.

Fence for war memorial

Risby Parish Council purchased a fence round the war memorial to help protect it

Water charges for allotment

One of the bills in 2015/16 was estimated. When the water meter was next read the bill was higher as a result.

Other

The Parish Council purchased new keys for the notice board
